All taxpayers should bring the following*:

- Photo ID for person making appointment (and/or spouse, if filing jointly)
- If married filing jointly, both spouses must attend appointment.
- Social security cards for every member of the family (If a card is lost, the taxpayer must contact the Social Security Administration to replace card prior to having taxes prepared.)
- W-2's and/or 1099's from ALL jobs worked in 2009
- A check from the taxpayer's checking account or a savings account number for direct deposit (NOTE: Taxpayers can open a bank account or cash card at the tax site for direct deposit if they do not have an existing account.)
- Interest statements from financial institutions (if applicable)
- Tuition and student loan information (if applicable)
- Documentation from daycare provider, if taxpayer paid for child care in 2009
- Any other income information or IRS notices received
- Copy of last year's tax return
