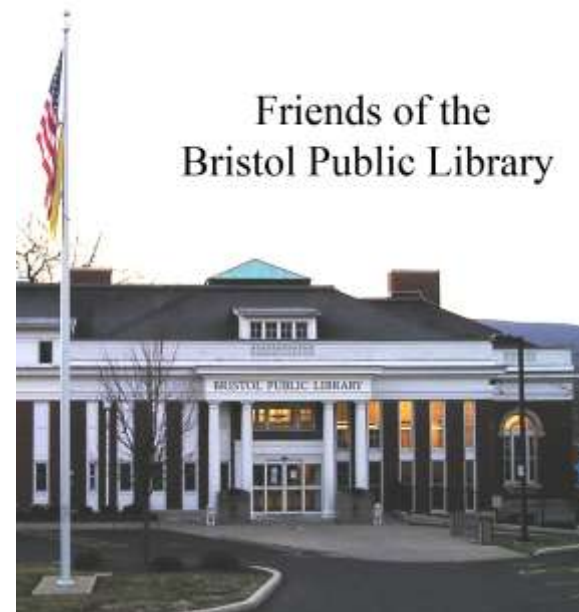

OUR PURPOSE...

The Friends of the Bristol Public Library, Inc. is a non-profit organization whose purpose is to promote our public library as a cultural, educational, and recreational asset to the city of Bristol/Forestville.

WHAT WE DO....

We sponsor and support special projects such as:

- Summer Reading Programs
- Public/Community programming
- Subsidized museum passes
- Book Page magazine

Many projects are joint ventures of the library and the Friends group focusing on library improvement.

We raise funds for library materials not supplied by normal budget resources. Items the Friends have purchased include furniture, computers, costumes and the message board. We also provide grants for special programs outside of the city Library budget.

We maintain a Friends Book Store for the sale of used books and audio-visual materials. This room is located on the lower level of the main library. Hours of operation are Monday, 1-3 pm., Thursday, 5-7 pm., and Saturday, 10-2 pm.

Book Sales. This is the main source of income. Our major book sale is held in February with mini sales in June and December.

Membership is open to anyone interested in supporting and improving the service and facilities of the Bristol Library. We are a volunteer organization that was begun in 1980.
